



The 9th ASEAN YOUTH CAMP THAILAND (AYCT 2025) CHIANG RAI, THAILAND

October 23rd -28th, 2025

Theme: Fusion Frontiers: Celebrating Diversity, Creating Art and Innovating Future

Background:

ASEAN English for Integrated Study Association: ASEISA, is a non-profit educational association aiming to commit to enhancing students, teachers, educators English communication leading by three pillars: Political-Security Community, Economic Community, and Socio-Cultural Community was launched in 2015. ASEAN Socio-Cultural Community, greatly focuses on the human aspect and practical content with the lives of all the people in the region. The mission is to push the establishment of ASEAN Socio-Cultural Community by promoting people's connection among nations and elevating the English language of ASEAN people according to the ASEAN Charter. This includes exchanging ideas, experiences and innovation concerning education, enhancing educational standards, and strengthening friendships amongst the members from Cambodia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, the Philippines, Indonesia, Singapore, Vietnam, Thailand, India and Bhutan.

ASEAN Youth Camp (AYC) is one of the main activities that AEISA launched in Mr. Kittiporn Intasida's vision, the chairman of AEISA and AEISA International committee. The aim of this event is to encompass student learning activities, teacher conferences and educational field trips. Thus, the first ASEAN Youth Camp started in Thailand in 2013. Since then, ASEAN Youth Camps have been annually organized at different schools amongst our country members. The first and second TAYC (Thailand ASEAN Youth Camp) was held at Kamalasai School, Kalasin Province, Thailand in 2013 and 2014. The third was held at Prapathomwittayalai School, Nakhonpathom Province, Thailand in 2015. The Fourth, at Rayongwittayakom School, the high school of Rayong province in 2016. The fifth was AYCI (ASEAN Youth Camp Indonesia), held at SMA 3 SUKABUMI, Indonesia in 2018. The sixth was AYCM (ASEAN Youth Camp Malaysia), held at SM Sains Johor, Malaysia. The 7th ASEAN Youth Camp was AYCV (ASEAN Youth Camp Vietnam), held at Nguyen Hue High School, Thua Thien Hue province, Vietnam in 2023. The 8th AYCP (ASEAN Youth Camp Philippines) was held at Berkeley high School in the Philippines last year in 2024. This year's AYC 2025 will be held here in Chiang Rai, Thailand.

Every year, hundreds of students and teachers from Asia and Southeast Asian regions participate in ASEAN Youth Camp. The success of AEISA's AYC is seen through the yearly increase in participants each year. In 2023, new participants from Japan and India participated in ASEAN Youth Camp Vietnam. Consequently, the camps have drastically enhanced cultural exchanges, English language skills, educational standards and friendships amongst our country members. For more than ten years, AEISA members have been collaborating with us on educational activities, which have opened doors of learning opportunities to our learners and educators around the regions. With the vision for educational development, AEISA endeavors to continue with collaboration with the educational institutes domestically and internationally. Our educational community has been growing during these years of achievement, bringing about international collaboration and will continue to succeed in the future. In 2024, ASEAN Youth Camp will be organized in the Philippines. Please, feel welcome to collaborate and shape our generations together.
